RULES OF THE TFG TFM MONDRAGON SARIAK AWARDS

2024 revision

1. PURPOSE: WHAT ARE THE MONDRAGON SARIAK TFG TFM AWARDS?

At MONDRAGON we want the profound transformation that our society is undergoing to be innovative, sustainable and people-based and, to achieve this, we need the contribution of young talent. That is why we want to award final degree projects (hereinafter "FDP") and final master's projects (hereinafter "FMP") that make an innovative contribution to the challenges of the 21st century.

The FDP or FMP must be submitted in only one of the following thematic categories:

- Danobatgroup Award for Digital Transformation.
- MONDRAGON Award for People-Based Transformation.
- Fagor Taldea Award for Energy-Climate Transformation.
- Orbea Award for Healthy and Sustainable.
- Laboral Kutxa Award for Transformation of finance to transform society.

Ten cash prizes will be awarded, 2 in each of the five categories described above:

- 2,500 euros for first place and
- 1,250 euros for second place.

50 diplomas will also be awarded to the 10 finalists in each category.

We also have two transversal awards:

- EIKA Award for the best project in Basque.
- IKERLAN Award for the most innovative project.

It is not necessary to register for these transversal prizes. The winner of each of these two awards will be chosen from among all the projects presented in the 5 thematic categories. Each of these two transversal categories will award a single prize of 2,500 euros to the winning project.

2. WHO IS ORGANISING THE AWARDS?

The MONDRAGON FDP/FMP Awards (hereinafter "the Awards") have been organised by MONDRAGON Corporación Cooperativa (hereinafter "MONDRAGON") with registered address at Paseo Arizmendiarrieta, 5, 20500, Arrasate and Tax ID Code (CIF) F20350823. The Awards also have:

- **Co-organising** Cooperatives:
 - \circ $\,$ Orbea S. Coop in the Healthy and Sustainable Mobility category.

- Laboral Kutxa S. Coop in the Transformation of finance to transform society category.
- **Sponsoring** Cooperatives:
 - Danobatgroup as the sponsor of the **Digital Transformation** category.
 - Fagor Taldea S. Coop as the sponsor of the **Energy-Climate Transformation** category.
 - Eika S. Coop. as sponsor of the prize for the **best project in Basque**.
 - Ikerlan S. Coop. as the sponsor of the prize for the **most innovative project**.

3. WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

All candidates of legal age in the current year and who have presented their FDP or FMP in a university between 1 October 2023 and 30 September 2024 are eligible to participate in the Awards.

The participating FDP or FMP must:

- Have obtained a minimum grade of 8 on a 10-point scale, or a percentage equivalent grade.
- Be related to one of the five thematic categories of the awards.

4. HOW AND WHEN CAN YOU PARTICIPATE?

The application period starts at 00:00 on 2 May 2024 and ends at 24:00 on 30 September 2024.

Applicants participating in the Awards must fill out the registration form available for that purpose in the Shaking Hub website (<u>https://community.shakinghub.com</u>).

The following data must be included in the **registration form**:

- Identification details of the author/s of the project.
- **Title** of the FDP or FMP.
- Abstract of the FDP or FMP with a maximum of **200 words**.
- Justification of the contribution to the theme to which the project is submitted, explaining the specific theme or themes to which it contributes with a maximum of 500 words.
- Justification of the originality, innovativeness and creativity of the project, explaining the extent to which the ideas or approaches are new or original and how they differ from other existing approaches with a maximum of **200 words**.
- Justification of the quality of the project, explaining the methodological approach used (by way of example, this justification may include objectives, phases, hypotheses, data processing, testing, sources or references used, among others) with a maximum of **200 words**.
- Sworn statement on the fulfilment of the requirements to participate in the Awards (being of legal age, date of submission of the FDP or FMP and the grade obtained).

The Jury of this contest may request any additional information deemed appropriate for its resolution, both from the author or authors of the project and from the university where the FDP or FMP was submitted.

Failure to meet the deadline or to provide any of the documents described above will result in the exclusion of the applicant from the evaluation process.

5. WHO EVALUATES THE FDPs AND FMPs AND HOW?

5.1 - Thematic categories

A Jury will be formed for each of the thematic categories specified in the Purpose of these rules. Each Jury will be made up of a Coordinator, jurors from outside MONDRAGON, jurors from MONDRAGON co-operatives and possible jurors proposed by the Universities.

The projects will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- **Contribution to the theme to which the project is submitted**. This aspect evaluates the relevance of the conceptual and/or practical contributions to the transformation challenges of the theme to which the project is submitted.
- The originality, innovativeness and creativity of the project. This aspect evaluates the distinguishing characteristics of the project compared to other existing projects or approaches.
- **Quality of the project.** This aspect evaluates the structure of the project, the methodological process, the systematic processing of data, sources or references and the writing clarity.

Projects will be evaluated in two phases:

- 1. Initial screening of the projects:
 - Finalist projects will be selected exclusively on the basis of the information provided by the candidates in the registration form; jury members will not have access to the complete project. We therefore stress the importance of filling out the registration form with the utmost care.
 - During this phase, the Coordinator of each Jury will ensure that the projects are evaluated in conditions of anonymity or "blind" evaluation.
 - This initial screening phase will conclude with the selection of **10 finalist projects in each of the existing categories.**
- 2. Evaluation of finalist projects:
 - During this second phase, the Jury will evaluate the 10 finalist projects by analysing both the registration form and the original project documents, selecting the two winning projects in each category.
 - The Coordinator of each Jury will ensure that jury members with direct links to the authors of the projects or to their university of origin refrain from evaluating them.

Some of the prizes may not be awarded, either because no projects have been submitted or due to the poor quality of those submitted.

5.2 - Transversal awards

A Jury will be set up for each of the two transversal awards indicated in the Purpose of these rules. Each Jury will be made up of a Coordinator, jurors from outside MONDRAGON and jurors from MONDRAGON co-operatives. The winning project for each of these 2 transversal prizes will be chosen from among all the 50 finalist entries in the 5 thematic categories.

The transversal awards will be evaluated as follows:

- 1. In the case of the prize for the most innovative project,
 - The Jury of each thematic category will propose two works from among the finalist projects in their category.
 - The Jury for the prize for the most innovative project will receive the proposals from the thematic juries and will choose the winning project from among all the finalists.
- 2. In the case of the prize for the best project in Basque, the jury in this category will evaluate the finalist projects written in Basque and will select the winning project. If there are no works written in Basque among the finalists, all the works submitted in Basque will be evaluated.

6. AWARD CEREMONY

The prizes will be awarded during an Award Ceremony scheduled to take place in the 28th of November 2024, at which the authors of the finalist projects must be in attendance. The authors of the finalist projects will be notified in advance of the date and location of the Award Ceremony by the organisation. Except in cases of force majeure, non-attendance at the Award Ceremony by the author or authors of a finalist project will entail the loss of the right to obtain the corresponding prize or diploma. The Jury will be responsible for assessing cases of force majeure. For the authors of the finalist works who reside outside the Autonomous Community of the Basque Country or outside the Autonomous Community of Navarre, MONDRAGON S. Coop. will pay the travel expenses to attend the prize-giving ceremony.

7. COMPATIBILITY AND GRATUITY OF PARTICIPATION

Participation in the Awards is compatible with any other awards for which the applicant is or has been eligible, or with any other contest, scholarship or grant.

Participation in the Awards is free of charge; no purchase or payment is necessary to participate.

Participation in the Awards implies acceptance of these rules. The Organiser reserves the right to modify or extend these Rules, provided that such modifications do not adversely affect the participants.
